

The Craft Training Center of the Coastal Bend was the focus of January’s vocational outing for Driscoll Middle School. The Craft Training Center provides hands-on training in crafts needed by local industry:

- Electricians
- Instrument Technicians
- Plumbing
- Crane Operators
- And more!

They provide training for both high school students interested in vocational trades and post high school students interested in learning a trade craft.

Allen Law, the Director of Education, visited Driscoll Middle School and talked to the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade classes to introduce the Craft Training Center. After the presentations, Driscoll staff picked the interested students to reward them with a field trip to the Craft Training Center.



The students received demonstrations in electrical, instrumentation, and welding during their tour. The demonstrations were led by the instructors Allen “volunteered” for this assignment.


